A WORD FROM THE PLAY'S AUTHOR We have made careful effort to remain true to the "Gospel Truth" in this drama.

Limited time and stage space necessitate that we do what we can with what we have, being careful that we remain true to God's word. An example of this is the Lord's Supper scene in which we simply do not have stage room for a long table. Another is the "Samhedrin" irial scene at the high priest's house. In the Bible, there are 70 men on that Sanhedrin court, we do good to scrape up a few! The Bible doesn't say everything that happened at Filate's house that day, but something did happen there which we have thete to "Dramatie". Many things in stage drama require you, the participant, to use your mental images to fill in the things we've had to leave out. The scene with the two mothers is ngt in out. scripture, but it is written to show part of the pain of our Lord's death. The important thing is not how we have chosen to dramatize these events, but that the source of the REAT "DRAM OF REDEMITION" did happen on Calvary's mountain. As in
