## **FOCUS: Why Sunday School**

## **KIDS Korner**

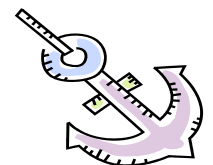
Zack & Cameron Matthews and Kaelyn Reynolds (my 3 yr. old granddaughter) participated in the Children's Ministry Day on Feb. 19th at Post Oak Baptist Church. They decorated cookies, learned who their neighbor was (everybody), then went prayer walking. We prayed by the Justice Center, Russellville PD and Logan Co. Sheriff's Dept. We prayed with employees at Russellville Fire Dept., Logan Co. EOC and the Jail, leaving bags of cookies with them. Returning to Post Oak, we had pizza and cookies! On Feb. 23rd, the preschoolers and children worked on mission projects, some to be used by the GO Ministry.

I'd like to share a few things learned from the Preschool & Children's Ministry Conference held in Bardstown Feb. 11-12. Shane Garrison, an assistant professor of education ministries at Campbellsville University, and there are three types of children attending our churches: 1) spiritual orphans, 2) 50/50, and 3) children of believing parents. Spiritual orphans do not have a believing parent or adult in the home. It is the church's responsibility to share Jesus with them, becoming the child's spiritual family. 50/50 families have one believing parent. Our responsibility is to stand beside the believing parent, to be an encourager. When both parents are believers, it is their responsibility to lead their child to Christ. It's vital that, as teachers or leaders, we have good relationships with the parents. When a child asks us about Jesus, we must direct them to share this with their parents...the parents need the joy of leading their child to Him. We can be their best encouragers!
