## KIDS KORNER

Summer vacation starts this month! That means VBS is just around the corner and all kinds of camps-for just about anything-will begin. We will continue to have our Wednesday night groups: Mission Friends, GAs and RAs. This would be a great time for the children to join us as they won't have to worry about it being a "school night". For parents, this is a good time to check us out and see what we do. For the third year, beginning this month through August, we will collect aluminum cans. There is never a news report that He didn't already know about before it happened. He knows the evil residing in men's hearts that will erupt in more death and violence. We must trust Him in these darkening times.

Lastly, Paul tells us in his letter to **Titus in chapter 2 verse 13** to "Look for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Savior Jesus Christ;" He is coming again and He is going to fix our world. As we see men's hearts continuing to darken can we pray with earnest, "even so, come Lord Jesus"? He is our hope. What is this world coming to? It's coming to Jesus! REACH Ministries
International is coming to
Russellville this summer! June
16-22 will be the camp
date. This non-profit
organization in the State of
Colorado was incorporated on
November 25, 1991. "Reach
Workcamps" is the trade name
used by Reach Ministries
International to represent all
workcamp activities. RMI is

not affiliated with any one church but serves all Christian churches and is governed by an interdenominational, National Board of Directors. There have been 135 Reach Workcamps since its birth and Madisonville, Ky. was the first camp location held in the summer of 1992. They have experienced a 70% youth group return rate. Youth groups from Tenn., Ga., Penn., N.C., and Ohio are making plans to attend this camp.

We are excited that they are coming to our town this summer and this will be a great experience for our youth. As has been with Ky. Changers, the work is always challenging, but the outcomes, both projects and spiritual growth, are outstanding!

Lodging and programs for this camp will be at the Logan County High School. LCHS health and physical education teacher Dan Duncan is Camp Coordinator.

May 5<sup>th</sup> -9<sup>th</sup> I will be leading revival music at New Harmony Baptist Church in Benton, Kentucky. Bro. Jason Sharp is the pastor of New Harmony.
